When you accept payments from our website through the Truist Association Services Online Payment System, you're simplifying the process for you and your homeowners.

Homeowners can make a payment online or enroll in Association Pay online by visiting Truist.com/payments and clicking the "Pay Now or enroll" link.

Make a payment by credit or debit card¹

• Homeowners can pay using Visa,® Mastercard,® American Express,® or Discover.® Payments are processed the following business day.

Make a payment by eCheck²

 Homeowners can pay by a one-time electronic funds transfer by ACH debit from their checking or savings account at a U.S. financial institution. Payment is processed within four business days.

Enroll in Association Pay (ACH)

Homeowners can enroll online for Association Pay
(ACH) to authorize recurring electronic funds transfers
by ACH debit from their bank account at a U.S. financial
institution. When payments are due, the account is
debited automatically on the third of the month. If the
third falls on a weekend or holiday, accounts are debited
on the next business day.

Multiple separate online payments can be submitted toward the same obligation; however, each separate payment transaction will incur a convenience fee. All debit cards issued by a U.S. financial institution will incur a flat \$4.95 convenience fee. All credit cards will incur a convenience fee of 2.95% of the payment transaction amount. The convenience fee incurred on debit cards issued by a non-U.S. financial institution varies. The exact convenience fee will be disclosed after card information is entered and before payment is submitted.

² The maximum payment amount is \$20,000 for a single eCheck payment transaction. Multiple separate online payments can be submitted toward the same obligation.
